#### Is your child due to start school in September 2020?

Was your child born between 1st Sept 2015 and 31st August 2016? You need to apply for your chosen school by either:-  
Creating an account online and submitting an online admissions form  
If you live in Bournemouth or Poole search:- **BCP School Admissions** or see below .

Closing date for applications is: **15th January 2020**

Schools in the area will be holding open days over this term to help when deciding which schools to apply for. During the open day you can visit the school during a working day. You'll be able to visit classrooms, and often pupils will show you round and talk to you about their school. We will be putting any information we receive about open days on our Facebook page or by email. See below.

#### Deadline for 30 hour Funding

**The 30 hour funding is allocated on a termly basis.**

If your child turns 3 years old this term and is eligible for the 30 hours funding, they will receive funding from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020. The deadline to apply and receive the 30 hour extended funding code is:

**31<sup>st</sup> December 2019**

If you miss this deadline, extended funding will not be allocated until April 2020.

#### 30 HOURS FUNDING

**It is your responsibility to reconfirm your code every three months so you don't lose your funding.**

You will receive a reminder from the Government and takes 5 minutes to reconfirm. We don't need this code.

**It is your responsibility to reconfirm. If this is not completed and eligibility finishes, then extended entitlement sessions will be stopped or you will be invoiced for payment of care already received.**

All 3 and 4-year-olds in England already get 15 hours a week of early education. If you are living in England and working over 16 hours per week, 3 and 4-year-olds may be entitled to 30 hours funded childcare. If eligible you will be entitled to access the 30 funded hours from the beginning of the term following your child's 3rd birthday. Please access the Government's website.
