Covid-19

In a recent statement from the South West Public Health authorities outlining the serious COVID-context across the South West at the moment is a clear reminder that COVID-19 is still very present in our lives and that we must all stay focused on limiting the spread as much as we can. We know that safety remains a key priority for our children, staff and parents and we want to reassure you that we will continue to do all we can to keep everyone safe.

We wanted to let you know about some measures we have re-introduced in our nursery to offer an enhanced level of protection.

With immediate effect Staff will be wearing face coverings when speaking to parents at drop off and collection, as well as in communal areas, however these will **NOT** be worn in the rooms during the session.

We would appreciate all parents/carers/grandparents to wear a face covering when dropping off and collecting at all times, this will be right up to the nursery door and when speaking to staff. Wearing a face covering on site is not mandatory and all responsible adults have a choice, however we believe this enhanced level of protection is keeping everyone safe and reducing the risk. My staff and I do respect the fact that some parents are exempt.

Is your child due to start school in September 2022?

Was your child born between 1st Sept 2017 and 31st August 2018? You need to apply for your chosen school by:-

3 and 4 year olds Christmas Nativity

Unfortunately, after much deliberation over the last few weeks, we have decided not to perform our Christmas play to a live audience at the church. This is due to the rise in Covid cases in the area and the increased risk to the spread this may cause, especially just before Christmas. We really hope you understand our reasons for this, as it hasn't been an easy decision.

We will however, be recording our play 'A Bundle of Joy' on <u>Tuesday</u>

<u>7th December</u> to create a lovely video of the nativity.

We would kindly ask that if your child does not normally attend on the morning session of Tuesday 7th December that you drop your child off at nursery, in their costumes at 9.30am and return to collect them at nursery at 11.30am. During this time we will record the children singing and acting and create a video for you to keep for years to come.

Winter clothing
